

Jefferson County Pee Wee Basketball Association

Rules 2018-2019

- A. The emphasis of the pee wee game should be placed on the development of basic skills, involvement of all players in the game, and on developing a positive attitude towards the game.
- B. Interscholastic competition at the 3rd and 4th level will be restricted to no more than fifteen (15) games per season. Seven (7) of the 15 games must be with other member schools of the association. The other games may be played against member or non-member schools. All teams will be permitted to play in one additional tournament outside the scope of the association without affecting the above-mentioned fifteen (15) accumulative games, so long as it does not disrupt regular association play in any regard.
- C. There will be no hosting of invitational pee wee tournaments by association members.
- D. The IJHSSA rules governing player eligibility will prevail as it relates to students who have been retained at grade level.
- E. The pee wee basketball season will run from January 1st through March 31st. The season, however, will end with the final game of the Jefferson County Pee Wee Tournament.
- F. Pee Wee basketball team practice will not begin prior to the 3rd week in November. The first basketball game cannot be played prior to January 1st.
- G. All players must have a completed annual physical exam form on file with their school prior to participating in pee wee sports.
- H. In so far as possible, games should be scheduled at times which cause the least amount of conflict with the players' academic responsibilities. Friday evening, Saturday, or after school might be good times.
- I. Only those teams who are officially sponsored by their local school district will be allowed to participate in the Pee Wee Association and the County Tournament.
- J. The scheduling of games should be completed between September 1 and October 15 of each year.
- K. Girls play each team in the association with a limit of ten (10) games total.
- L. Tournament play will be single elimination until all teams have played regardless of eligibility. Teams who play ineligible players will forfeit the game.
- M. When scheduling games, every team must play each other once, before scheduling a team twice.
- N. IJHSAA RULES SHALL APPLY IN ALL INSTANCES WHERE SITUATIONS ARISE WHICH ARE NOT COVERED BY THE RULES ABOVE.
- O. We will play 6 minute quarters for **ALL** pee wee games.
- P. Each team will have 5 timeouts a game (2 partial /3 full). 1 timeout will be added to remaining timeouts from a game in overtime. Overtime will be by 3 minute increments.
- Q. All teams will play behind the 3 point line on defense. Once the offensive team has crossed the half line the defensive team can come out to the half line.
- R. Teams will be allowed to press **full court** for the last minute of each half and overtime.
- S. All pee wee teams will use 28.5" girls' basketball.
- T. Home gym will provide basketballs for both teams to use.
- U. All pee wee teams are allowed to shoot free throws from an 11ft free throw line.
- V. Home team wears white and visiting team wears dark uniforms.
- W. All made baskets except for free throws will be scored as 2 point field goals.
