Whatever news source you use, if you spend five minutes with the news, you'll see the impacts. Jefferson County has had an infection rate that has slowly climbed as the state has begun to reopen. The Jefferson County Health Department has been a great source for information on COVID-19 cases in our area. As of August 31st, there have been 481 total positives. This includes 89 active cases who are currently in isolation, 361 which have been released from isolation, and 7,178 negative test results. With this comes the unfortunate news of 31 total deaths by coronavirus.

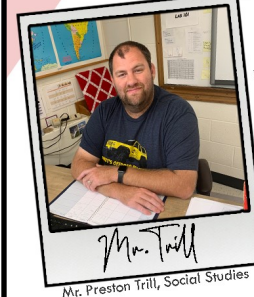
A number of our favorite activities have been impacted by the circumstances. On August 25th, the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity and Illinois Department of Public Health announced new statewide safety guidelines for restaurants and bars. Based on the recent increase of cases, the IDPH is now requiring all customers to wear a mask during any interaction with the wait staff and any other employees at the bar or restaurant they are attending. Face coverings must be worn over the nose and mouth when customers are approached and served by staff, including but not limited to when employees take orders, deliver food and beverages, and service tables. This will also apply to places like museums and indoor recreational facilities who also have food services areas. These guidelines will go into effect on August 26th and will require face coverings to be worn in indoor and outdoor settings.

As 2020 rolls on, it's clear that like Americans have done so many times in the past, citizens need to come together to do their part. Whether it's checking out a museum exhibit, enjoying a good dinner out, or any number of other activities, let's do what we can to put these circumstances in this strange year in our rearview mirror as quickly as we can!

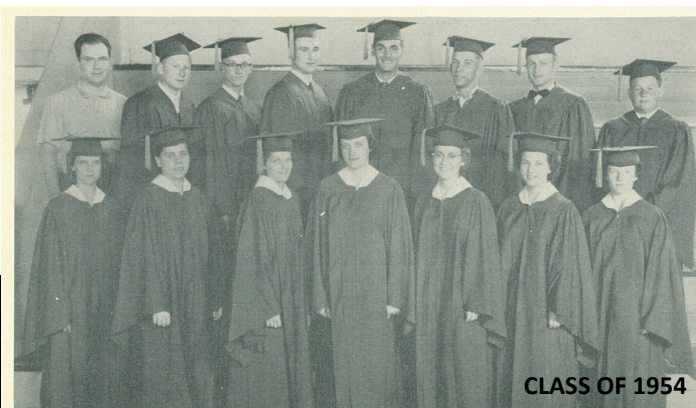
