Woodlawn Grade School

- Due to IDPH limitations on the number of spectators and spacing, spectators will not be allowed inside Woodlawn Grade School. Participants, coaches, officials and game support staff will only be allowed inside the gymnasium.

- The district will communicate the status of spectators and streaming video for road venues as soon as it is known.
- Participants should arrive at the event dressed to play upon arrival and should bring their own drinks, labeled for their own personal use.
- As the Woodlawn High School gym will allow for a small number of spectators, some WGS events will be moved to WHS. Games played at WHS will be broadcast via the National Federation of High Schools. <https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/> This is a subscription service. Woodlawn High School

- Due to IDPH limitations on the number of spectators and spacing, limited spectators will be allowed for basketball games held at Woodlawn High School. Participants, coaches, officials, working radio and print media, and game support staff will only be allowed inside the gymnasium.
 - Only fans of the home team will be allowed, with each player receiving one pass.
 - Fans should be prepared to sign in and leave a telephone number for contact tracing, in the event it is needed.
 - Fans must sit 6 ft apart.
 - All fans must wear a mask at all times while in the building.
 - Basketball- fans must sit only in the top row of the bleachers opposite the scorer's table.
 - Volleyball- fans must sit in only the top row or the row that is 3rd from the top
 - As space is limited, we ask that once the junior varsity game is over, that those parents vacate the building to allow another group of parents to attend the varsity game.

Transportation

Coaches will assign seats on the bus for all away games to allow for as much distance as possible. When possible, it is preferable that students ride home from games with their parents.

Visiting Team Parents Who Have to Transport Their Children

We are going to attempt to have a viewing area for parents from opposing schools that do not provide athletic transportation. A projector will be set up with a live feed of the game. It is expected that social distancing guidelines are adhered to and attendees remain masked while in the building. Please do not attempt to gain access to the gym.

Game Day Setup Routines

- The gym will be arranged with spectators and participants on opposite sides.
- Player seating will be spaced out with at least six (6) feet between each chair. It is expected that coaches monitor and maintain spacing throughout the contest.
- The score table will be reserved for one scoreboard operator, the official bookkeeper and the guest scorebook.
- A minimum of two game balls will be provided. At times specified by the governing body, balls will be sanitized and rotated.
- For basketball a separate rack of balls will be provided for each team.
- Due to space limitations, it may be necessary for the varsity team to sit elsewhere in the building during the JV game.
- Locker rooms will not be utilized. Participants should arrive at the event dressed to play upon arrival. Space will be provided for teams for the halftime break.
- All players should bring their own water/sports drinks for personal use.

Positive COVID Case

In the event that there would be a positive COVID case on one of the athletic teams, all students on the team will be considered a close contact. As such, the team would be subject to school quarantine procedures and be excluded from school attendance and extracurricular activities for 14 days from the last contact with a positive case. The only exception will be in the event the structure of a practice in question allows for the separation of players, or groups to players, without intermingling.
